I grant your July 22, 2019 request for Cameron LNG, LLC (Cameron LNG) to commence service for liquefaction and export activities from Train 1, the associated Outside Battery Limits facilities, and the associated Regas facilities. Your request is in compliance with Environmental Conditions 12, 72, and 73 of the Commission's June 19, 2014 *Order Granting Authorization Under Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act and Issuing Certificates* (Order), in the above-referenced docket. Based on Commission staff inspections and review of the commissioning activities for the Cameron Liquefaction Project, Cameron LNG has demonstrated that the above-mentioned facilities have been constructed in accordance with Commission approval and applicable standards and can be expected to operate safely as designed.
